Sir,

I am directed to state that on consideration of the observations made by the Expert Committee and the recommendations made by the Western Regional Committee (WRC), the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) has accorded approval to Ramdeobaba Kamla Nehru Engineering College, Nagpur, Maharashtra to conduct the following degree courses in Engineering with the annual intake shown against each from the academic year 1993-94:

S.No.	Name of the Course	Intake
1.	Civil Engineering	60 (sixty)
2.	Electronics Engineering	60 (sixty)
3.	Industrial Engineering	60 (sixty)
4.	Electronics & Power Engineering	60 (sixty)
5.	Mining Engineering	30 (thirty)
6.	Electronics Design Technology	30 (thirt)
Total =		300

The approval given above is subject to the following conditions:

(1) NO FURTHER INCREASE IN INTAKE BEYOND THE ABOVE TOTAL INTAKE OF 300 WILL BE ALLOWED. THE COLLEGE MAY, HOWEVER, APPROACH AICTE FOR ADDITION OF ANY COURSE ADJUSTING THE INTAKE WITHIN THE TOTAL INTAKE OF 300.

(2) The teaching and technical supporting staff shall be recruited to come at par with the AICTE norms within one year.

(3) No new course shall be started in the Engineering College without the prior approval of the AICTE.

(4) The intake in any year shall not be altered without the prior approval of the AICTE.


- (5) The AICTE scales of pay shall be introduced for the teaching and other staff.
- (6) The Management including the Governing Council of the College shall be constituted as per the AICTE guidelines and also the Chairman shall be appointed as per the AICTE guidelines.
- (7) Admissions shall be made on merit as per the guidelines issued by the AICTE and no capitation or donation of any kind shall be charged for admissions.
- (8) The tuition and other fees shall be charged as prescribed by the State Government within the overall criteria prescribed by the AICTE from time to time.
- (9) ✓ The teaching staff shall be recruited on an All India basis by open selection, and as per procedure, qualifications, experience, etc. as prescribed by the AICTE from time to time. State-based selection would be permissible for such posts for which the State Government prescribes "State-based selection" as a general policy.
- (10) The accounts of the College shall be audited by a Chartered Accountant and be open for inspection by the AICTE or anybody authorized by it.
- (11) The College shall follow strictly any further conditions as may be laid down by the AICTE from time to time.

This approval is also subject to full compliance with the SCHEME as prescribed by the Supreme Court in its judgement dated 4.2.1993 on W.P.(C) No. 607 of 1992 with other WPs in the case of Unnikrishnan, J.P. and other etc. etc. vs State of Andhra Pradesh and others etc. etc. and the related guidelines and criteria as may be issued by the AICTE, UGC or the Central Government from time to time.

In the event of non-compliance by the Society or the College with the above conditions, the AICTE will be free to take measures for the closure of the programme and withdrawal of its approval without consideration of any related issues and that all liabilities due to closure would be that of the Society and/or the College.

You are requested to kindly take necessary action in the matter and keep the WRC, Bombay and this Office informed of the progress made in this behalf.

GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSION OF SPONSORED  
CANDIDATES TO FULL-TIME PG DEGREE PROGRAMMES

Ref. 8th Meeting of the RO of the AICTE held on 15.02.95


The following guidelines are laid down for admission sponsored candidates to full time PG degree programmes.

- (i) The Candidates who possess Bachelor's degree in Engineering / Technology / Pharmacy / Architecture / Planning or equivalent from AICTE approved institutions which at least 55% marks will be eligible for admission.

The minimum percentage of marks may be waived for those who are teachers either in Engineering Colleges or Polytechnics joined before 28.2.1989, the date on which the circular was issued prescribing the AICTE pay scales and qualifications.

Preference should be given to those candidates who are GATE qualified. Sponsored candidates will not be eligible to receive scholarship, even if they are admitted based on GATE score.

- (ii) The candidates must have a minimum two years of full-time work experience in a registered firm/company/industry/educational and research institutions/any Government Departments or Government Autonomous Organisations in the relevant field in which admission is being sought.
- (iii) There will not be any age restriction. However, preference should be given to those who are below 45 years of age.
- (iv) The mode of selection shall be such that merit is the sole criterion. No capitation fee or donation will be charged for admission.
- (v) A letter from the employer must be furnished stating that the candidate is being sponsored to get admission. The employer should also indicate that the candidates will not be withdrawn midway till the completion of the course.
- (vi) The fee structure for the sponsored candidates should be as decided by the concerned institutions. The fee for the candidate should normally be borne by the sponsoring organisation wherever possible.
