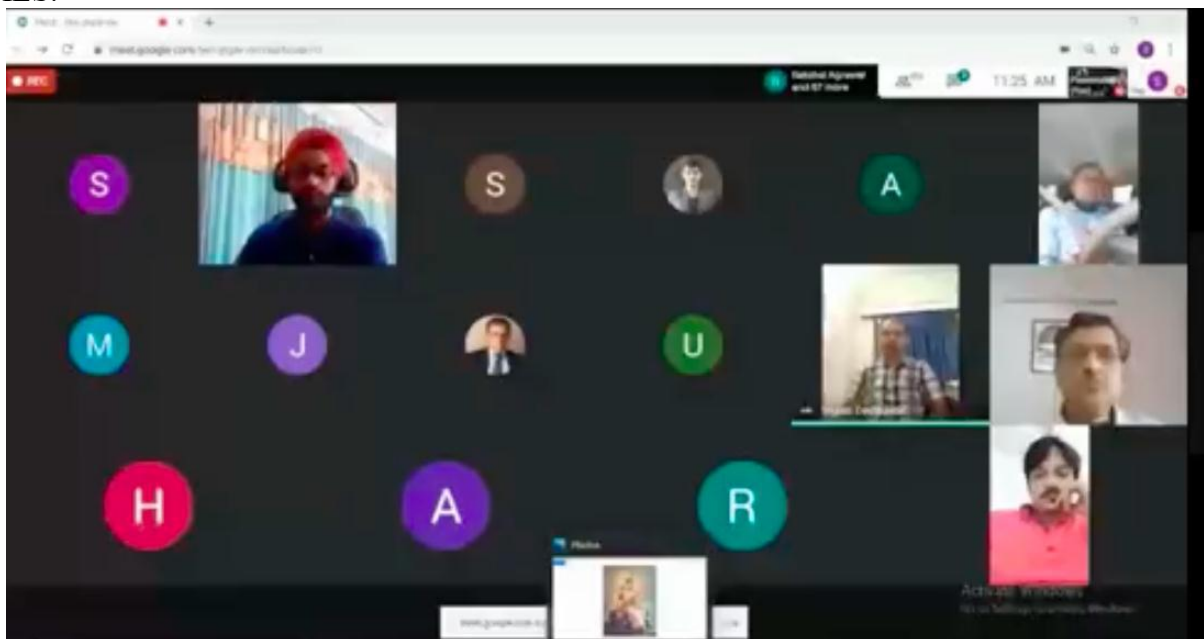


Teachers Day Celebration

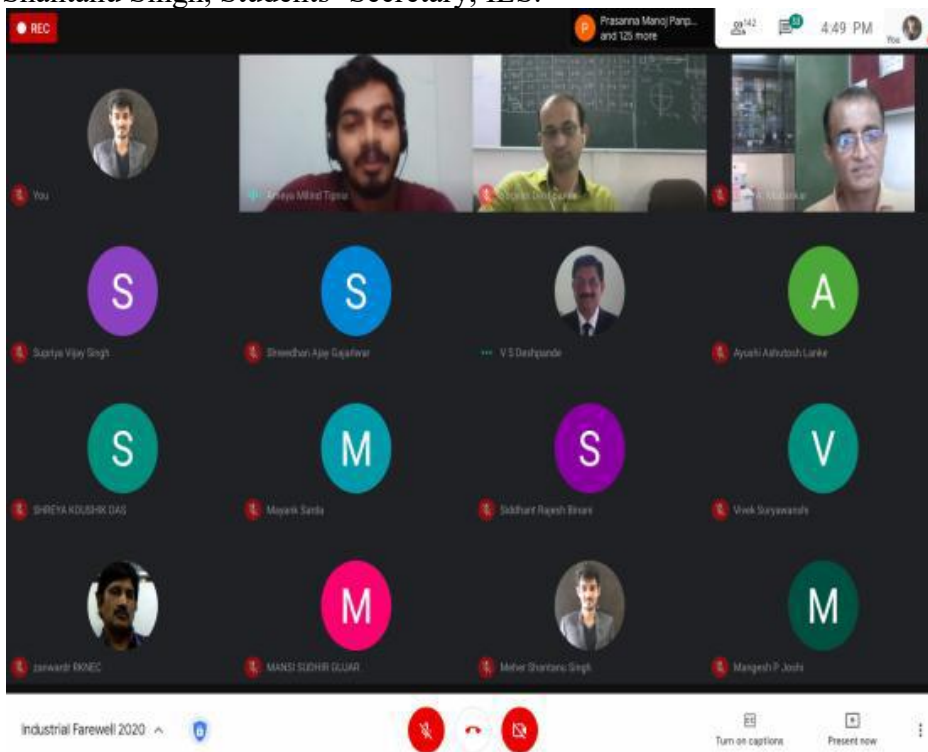
Students of 2nd year gave musical performances given which highly mesmerizing for teachers. Students expressed their love and respect for teachers with a poems and songs.

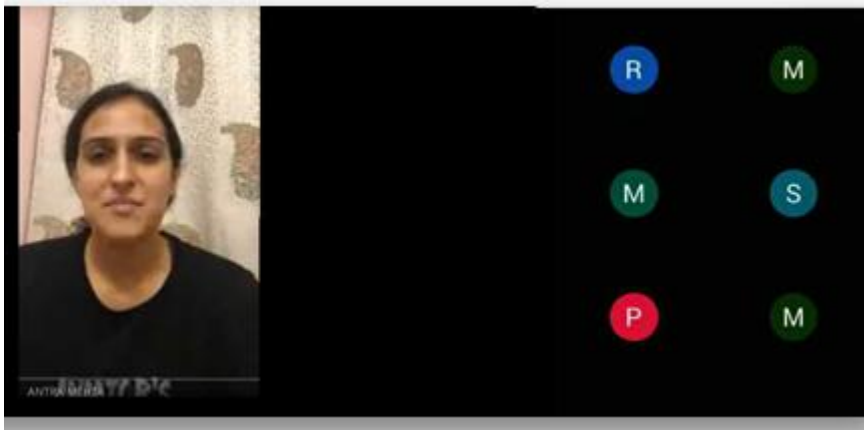

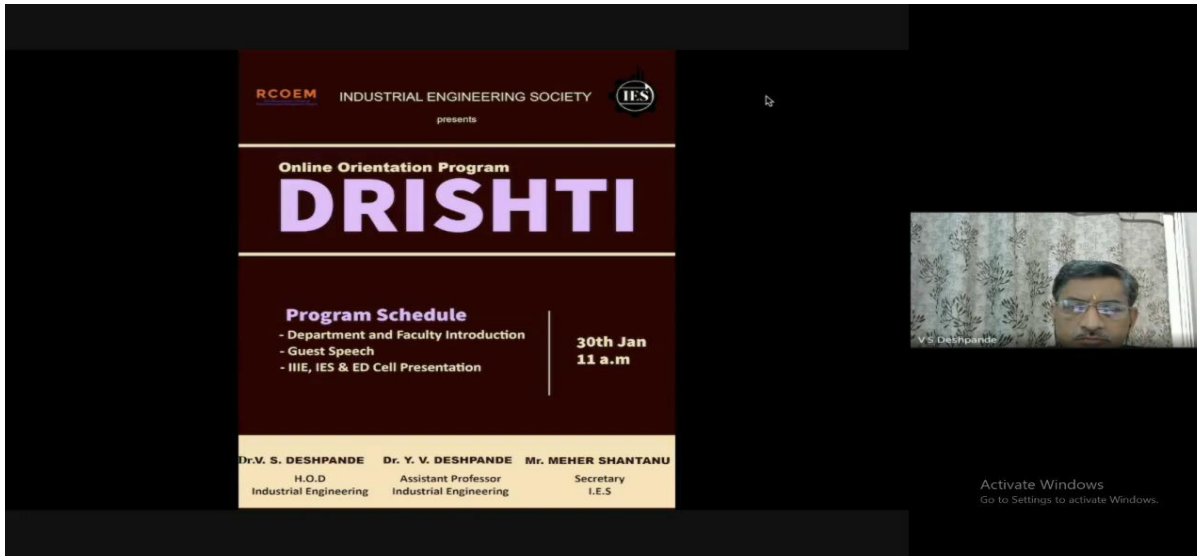
Guest lecture on “Becoming Project Manager through Artificial Intelligence”

DRISHTI – The Indus Way

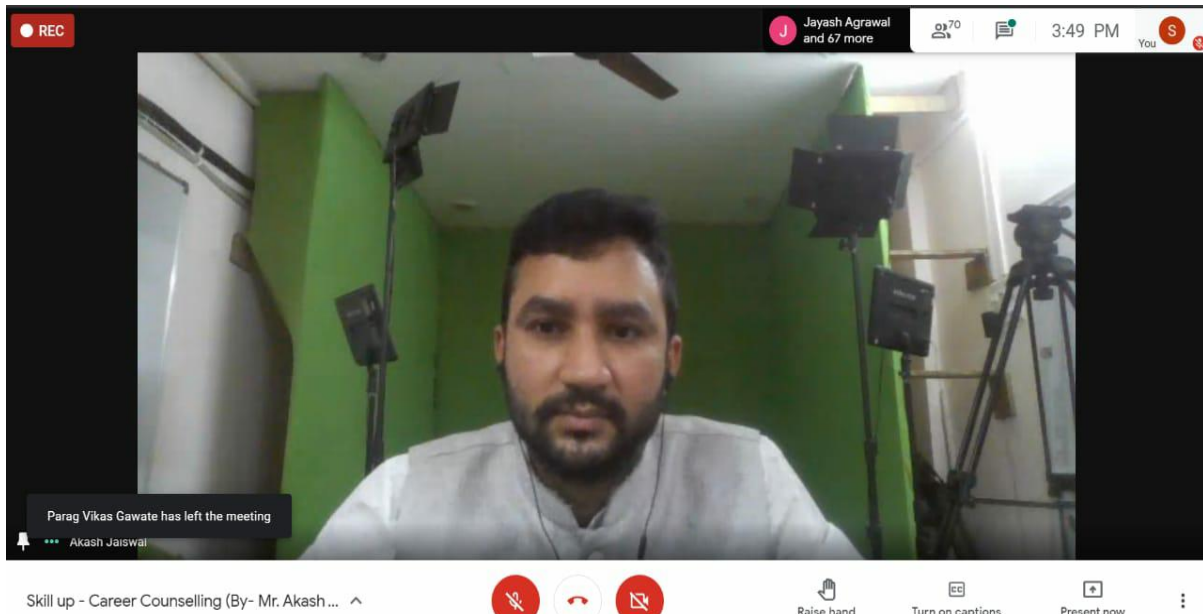

Skill up Webinar on Career Opportunities after Engineering

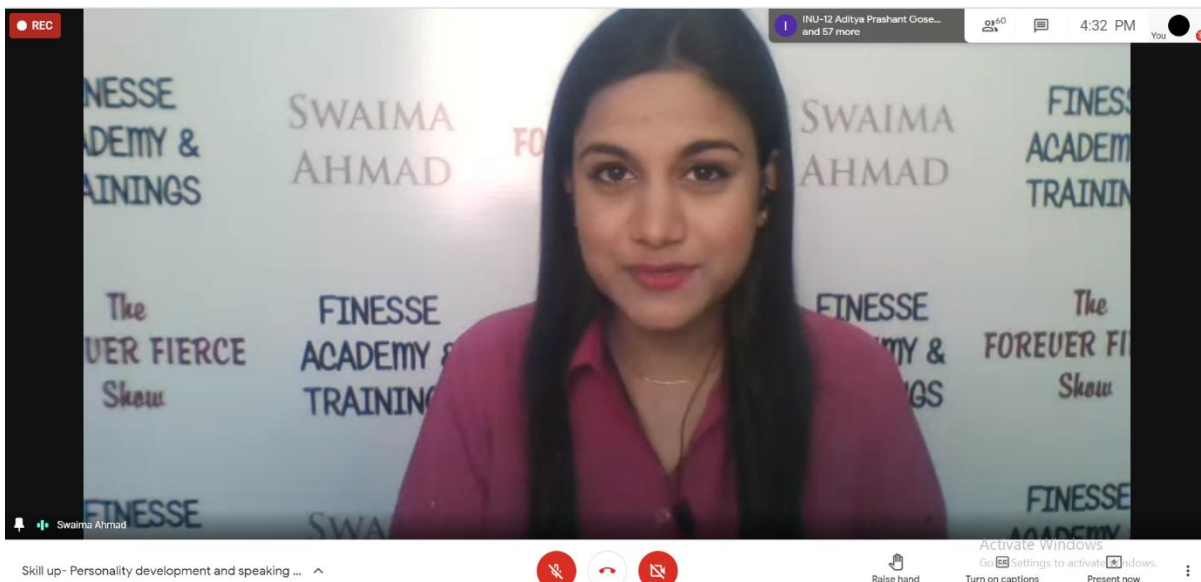
