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stealing credit/debit card details. He also stressed on the corrective measures to be taken to protect the credentials.

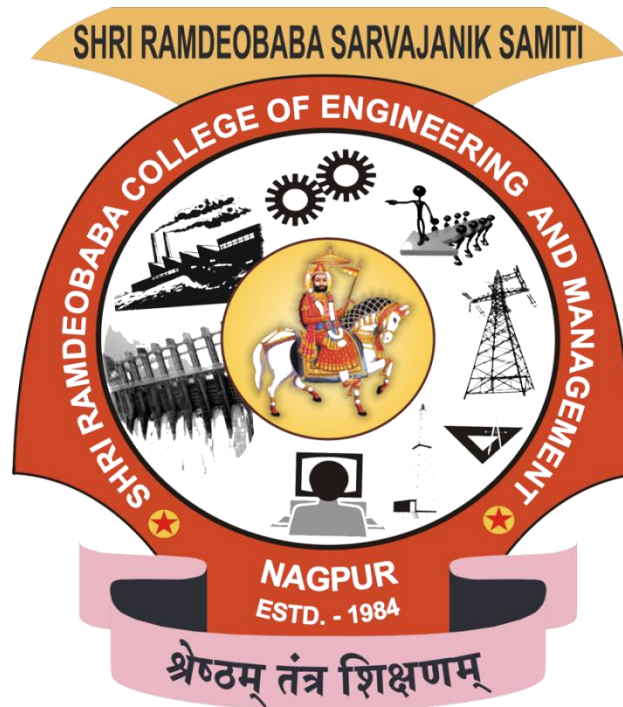
