All the teams participated and played enthusiastically with the spirit to win the game. After the completion of Round-1, 8 out of 15 teams were qualified for the further rounds.



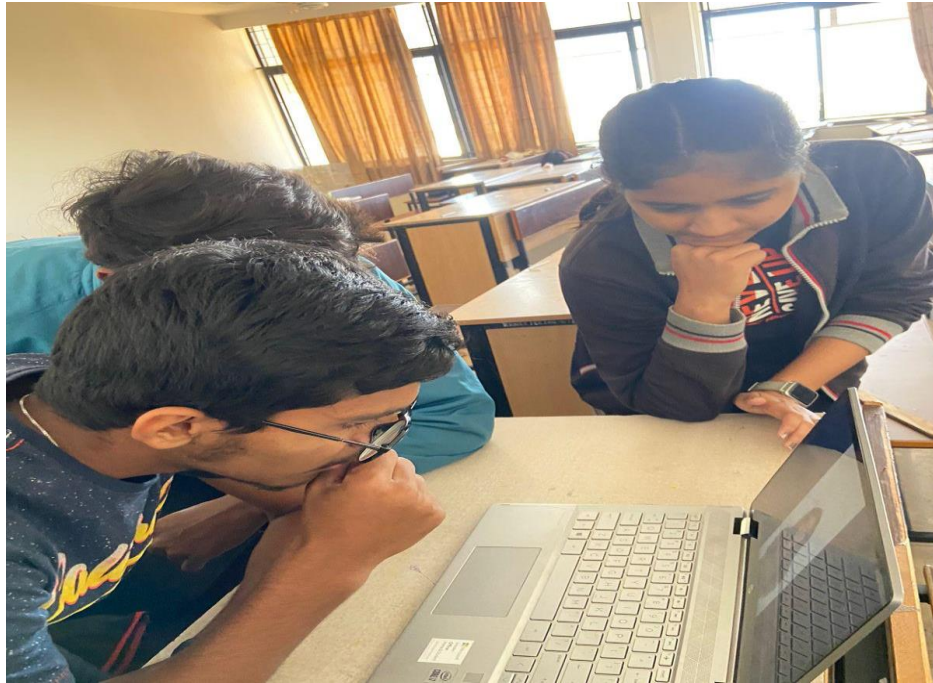

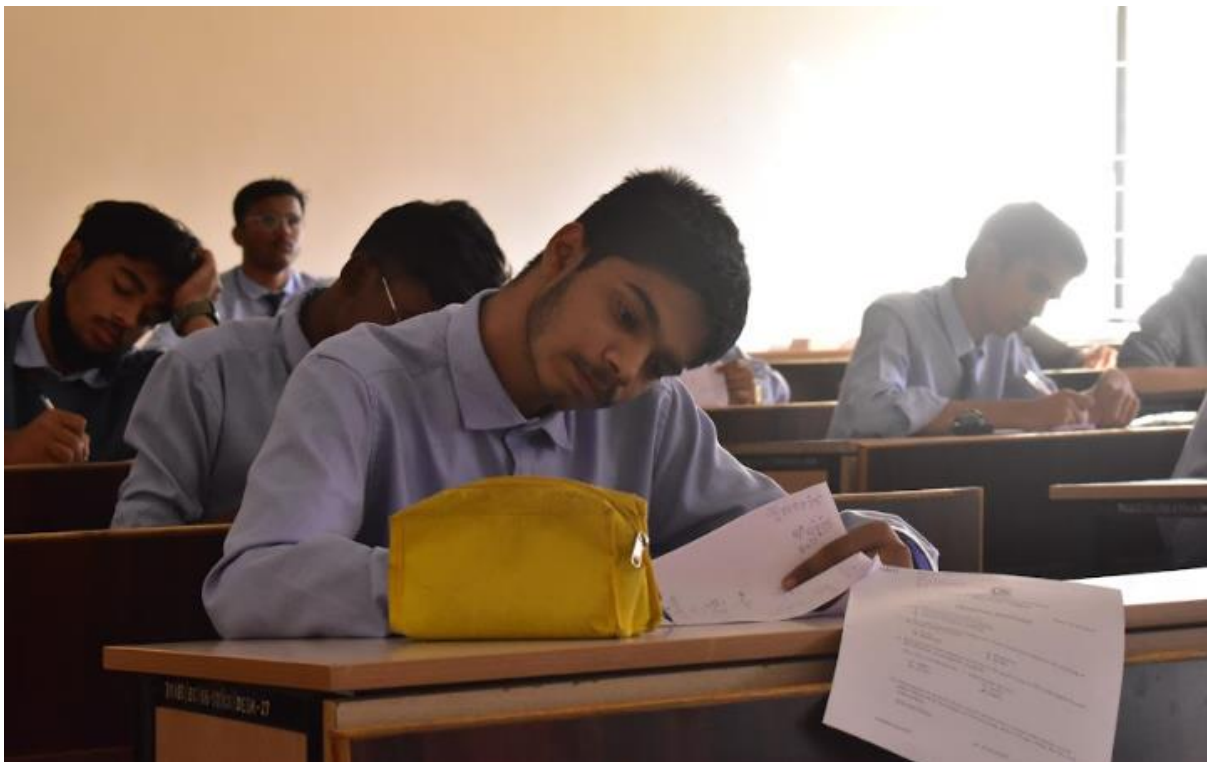
The event was conducted in 3 rounds which are enlisted below:

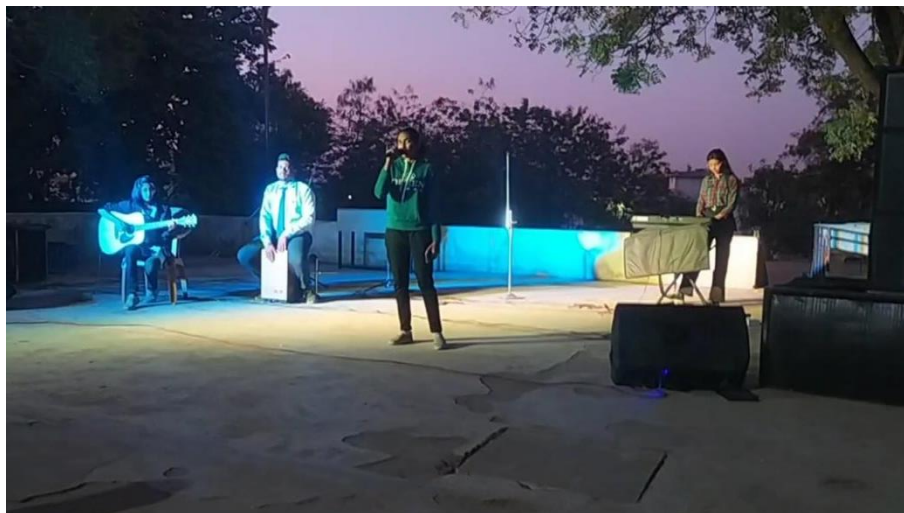
