Mr. Ameya Khambete spoke about the evolution of 3D printing technique and how this is benefiting the present research world. He discussed about the evolution of Additive Manufacturing from Subtractive Manufacturing. He used few videos to make students understand the importance of AM (Additive Manufacturing); which was greatly appreciated by the students.

Along with him, few other employees of the organization were present. They informed the students about their organisation's profile.
