Activities

1. Orientation Program for 2nd Year UG Students:

An orientation program for second year students (1st shift and 2nd shift) was organized in the department of Electronics Engineering on 13/07/2019. At the outset Prof. Vishal Rathee, ELECTROLITZ Society Incharge, welcomed the students and introduced all the faculty members of the Department to the students via website. Dr. A. A. Khurshid, HOD, Electronics Engineering Department, then briefed the students about the vision and mission of the department. Dr. A. A. Khurshid also discussed various computing facilities, laboratories available, about different clubs and societies in the department. She briefed the students about the changes in curriculum, Major and Minor schemes, open electives, challenges that can be encountered while obtaining placements or going for higher studies and how to tackle them. She urged the students to aim big, create opportunities by accepting challenges, maintain a good academic record and participate in events that improve their overall personality thereby improving their chances of placements with higher packages and in renowned companies. She also warned the students regarding disciplinary action if found involved in malpractices and urged them to distance from it. Also students were told about the students' society ELECTROLITZ which organizes different activities and events at department level. Over 100 Students took part in the program.

Prof. Smita Daware, DEC (Department Exam Committee) In-charge briefed the students with current academic calendar, policies & ordinances related to examination pattern of internal test and end semester exam, marks distribution, incentive criteria, Assessment pattern, rules for appearing in makeup exams & all other exam related work/patterns.

Dr. R. S. Ochawar, Project Coordinator briefed the students about current procedure to form a group and selection of project topic. She briefed the students on how many times the projects will be evaluated in a semester, it's marking scheme and what level of work is expected from the students in the project and urged the students to prepare a roadmap for selection of good projects when they are in their final year.

Prof. B. M. Hardas, Academic Coordinator stressed on "Academics First" theme i.e. academic activities over all other extra and co-curricular activities. He told about the Academic rules & regulations as per ordinances regarding attendance, policies for appearing in end semester examination, remedial classes and its significance and explained about detention criterion. He apprised student about GEMS and how to use it for academic purpose.

Prof. Vikas Gupta, Career Counseling Cell (CCC) Coordinator explained to students the importance of counseling in his/her life thereby emphasizing the need to establish such a cell in the department. He asked the students to visit college website for more information on this cell elaborating on few points like its objective of establishment for helping students to identify a right career path after completing their graduation.

He assured the students of conducting various activities under this cell which would help them to acquire broad knowledge of various fields & skills needed for employment. He apprised students about the different higher studies opportunities in the country.

Prof. Rushikesh Deshmukh, III Cell and Embedded Club in charge briefed about Industry Institute Interaction Cell (III Cell), which provides ample opportunities for industry exposure to students through industry visits, research, summer internships and industry projects. He also briefed the students about the incubation centre of the college and various activities conducted under it for young entrepreneurs. Being Embedded Club In charge as well, which creates a platform for sharing innovative ideas and inculcates research acumen amongst the student, he discussed about how this club aims at enhancing basic knowledge and skills to come up with constructive and useful Embedded Electronic Systems. He urged the students to actively participate in the preparing activity chart for this club.

Prof. Lokesh Heda, Training & Placement Cell Coordinator briefed the students about various activities conducted under Training & Placement Cell in accordance with the central T&P. He detailed students about how large the window of opportunity is in this college and the wide variety of careers available for them both in India and abroad. He briefed students about the type of preparation required to get into a good company and also told them from where and how to do it. He also made aware the students with the departmental placement records of last two years and the companies that have been visiting for recruiting them. He told students to focus on soft skills and aptitude development. He also added that students should learn foreign languages for abroad opportunities as well as try for off campus placements with higher packages and need not shy away from taking the help of third party companies like Hiremee, Aspiring Minds, FACE, etc. for it. In the end he briefed students about the Eighth Semester Internship scheme of the department and its benefits.

Ms. Priyanka Buty thanked the teachers for their gracious presence while Prof. Vishal Rathee thanked the students for organizing such a wonderful function.




7. One week technical workshop Entrix 12.0

A one week technical workshop for Second year students ENTRIX 12.0 was conducted at Electronics Engineering department of Shri Ramdeobaba College of Engineering & Management from 14th December 2019 to 21st December 2019. The inaugural function was held on 13th December 2019. Mr. Amjad Khan, Management Consultant & EX-GM HR CEAT LIMITED, was the Chief Guest for the inaugural function. Dr. S. D. Mohagaokar, Dean Second Shift, RCOEM presided over the function. Dr. (Mrs.) A.A. Khurshid, HOD, Prof. Vishal Rathee and Prof.Snehal Laddha-Convenor ENTRIX 12.0; Mr. Shivam Deshmukh- ENTRIX 12.0 Head and Mr. Pratik Pandey-Technical Coordinator ENTRIX 12.0 were prominently present on the dais.

Yasha Sahare of 6th Semester EN Section B gave a brief overview about what had happened on the fateful day of 14th February 2019 and asked all the present to observe two minutes silence to offer peace to the souls of martyrs. 9. Guest lecture on E-waste under Seva Disha Cell of Electrolitz society

A guest lecture on creating awareness on E-Waste Management was organized under Electrolitz students' society on 13 Feb 2020. 10. Webinar on "COVID and YOUth" under Seva Disha Cell.

An online webinar for creating awareness amongst youth about COVID -19 was organized under Electrolitz students' society on 14 June 2020. Dr. Sajal Bansal, Ex. Medical officer at MAYO, Junior Doctor Network, IMA, Nagpur coordinator, conducted the awareness session on COVID -19 for students and staff. A total of 125 registrations were received for the session.

Dr. Bansal in his presentation addressed the various myths and facts about COVID. He apprised the audience on various aspects of COVID like what are the symptoms of COVID, when to go for the COVID test, things to be done and not to be done if a person is detected with corona virus, how to save ourselves from this deadly virus, how to prevent it's widespread at individual level as well as at mass level. He also provided clarification on some of the myths like spread of corona virus from mosquitoes or pets, less prevalent amongst children, etc. In his address he urged the participants to frequently wash their hands, use sanitizer, avoid touching unknown things and places, wear mask and go into self isolation if not feeling well. Discussing the adverse effects of corona virus on human body and mind, he emphasized on the important role that an engineer can play in this pandemic. Concluding the session he briefly discussed about projects that can be developed by students to support frontline health workers in cambating COVID and urged everybody to contribute so as to defeat corona virus.
