The motive behind these events being to gain technical knowledge and improve interpersonal skills in fun but effective way by competing with their peers.


#### **Description of event:**


### Quizzique-

This event was conducted in a fun and entertaining way to gain technical knowledge in which students of all the branches of RCOEM currently in the third and final year were eligible to participate. Quizzique comprised of 3 rounds where questions from the topics Movies, Games, General Knowledge, Current affairs, Government strategies and Basic Engineering Questions were asked.

#### Round 1

All participants were asked to join a Zoom meeting where 15 questions were to be answered in 15 secs. each. The questions were shown live in the meet and the participants marked the answers in a google form which only had options in it.






Top 50 from Round 1 qualified for Round 2.

5 simultaneous Zoom meets with 10 participants each was asked questions with camera and microphone ON and was conducted in 'next direct' manner.






1 Winner from each panel qualified for the Finale.


## Round 3


# It had 3 Sub Rounds:

- 1. 5 questions for Sound and 5 Questions Picture based. 10 points for correct, zero for wrong and pass.
- 2. 2 questions to each participant (on their favorite topic) with an option to raise stakes. 20 if raise stakes and correct, -5 if raise stakes and wrong. If not risen stakes 10 and zero for right and wrong.
- 3. Only one question to each participant on their favorite topic. 30 points per question. If first hint taken then question worth 20, if second hint also taken then question worth 10 points. If chosen to answer anywhere within hints then zero.









After all the three sub rounds the final two winners were crowned.

Finale Round was also streamed live on YouTube.

Master. Shashwat Sinha (EC 3<sup>rd</sup> year, 1<sup>st</sup> shift) was declared winner. Master. Kunal Kanojiya (EC 3rd year, 2<sup>nd</sup> shift) was declared 1<sup>st</sup> runner -up.

The event was conducted smoothly with active participation by the participants and the organizing team.
