Gyanodaya – First year induction program at Shri Ramdebaba College of Engineering and Management, Nagpur

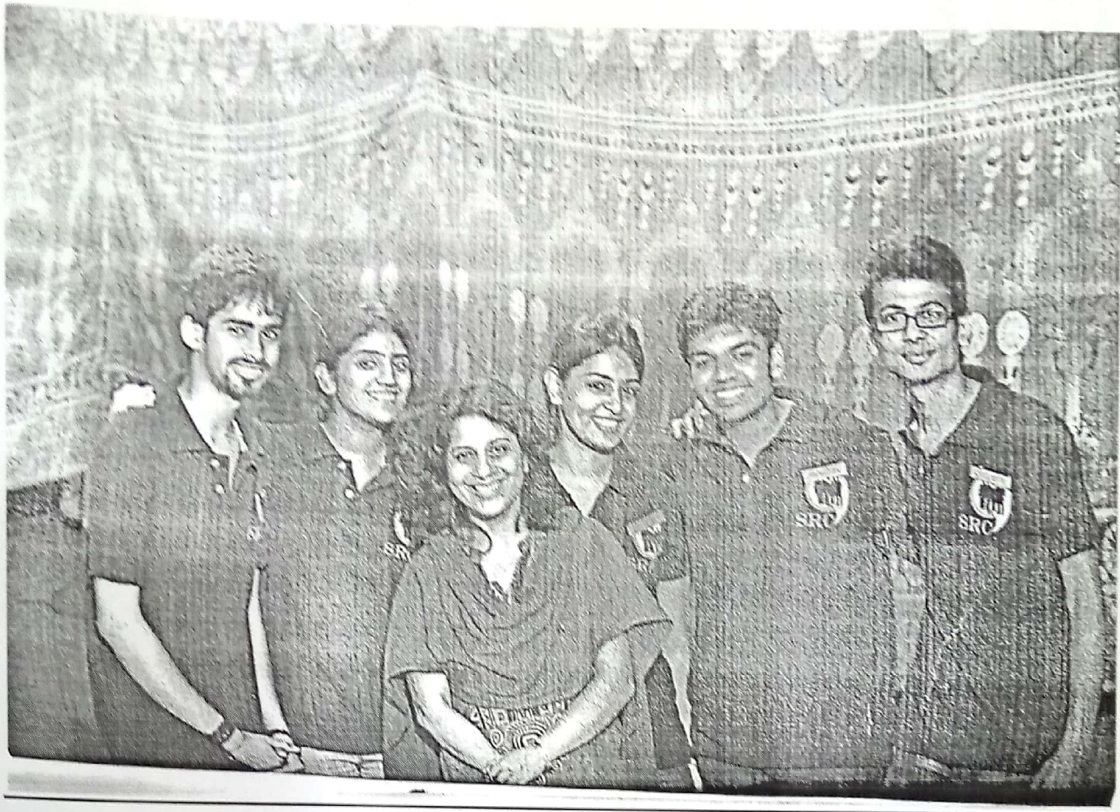

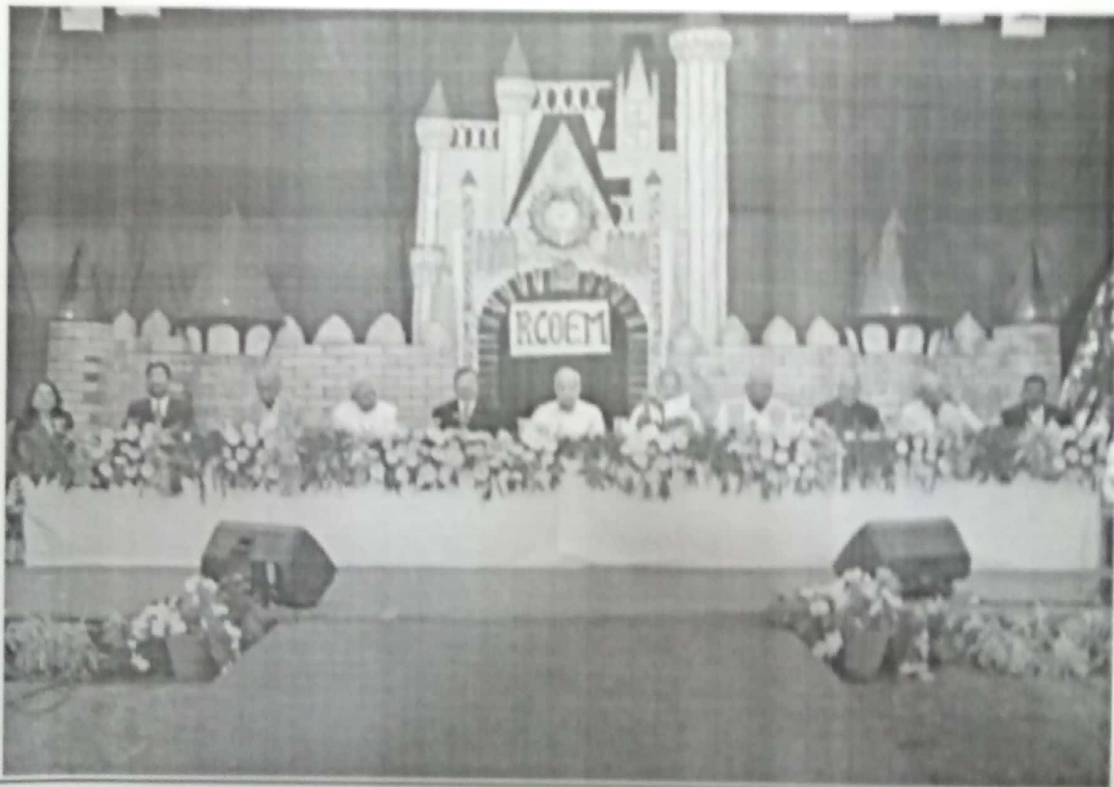
