- The whole event is planned solely for the first year students, keeping in mind their expectations.

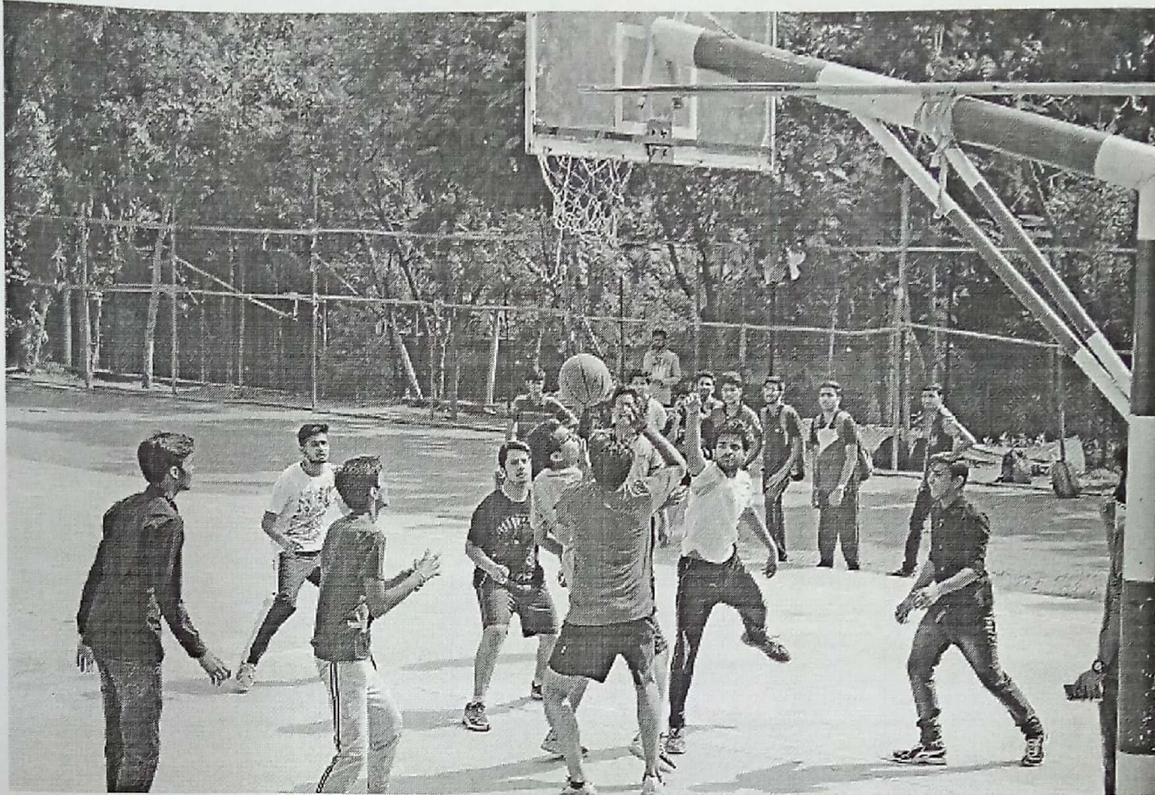

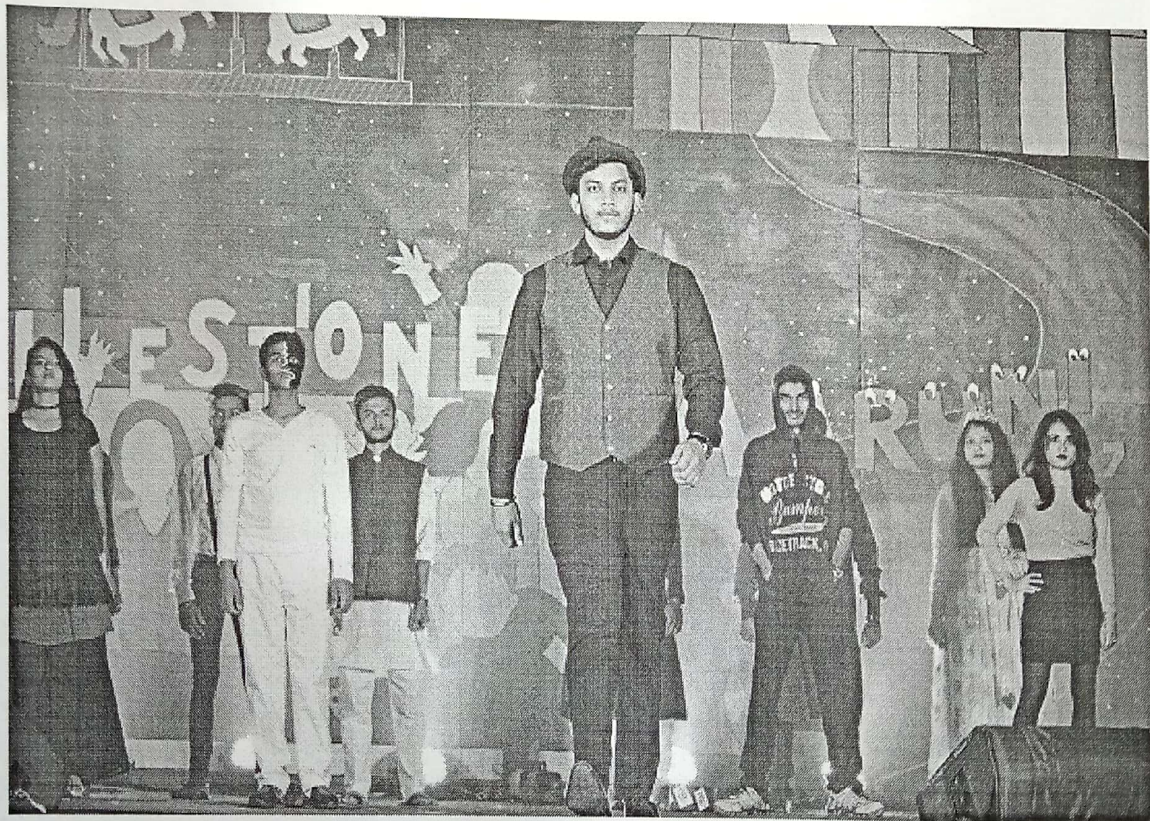

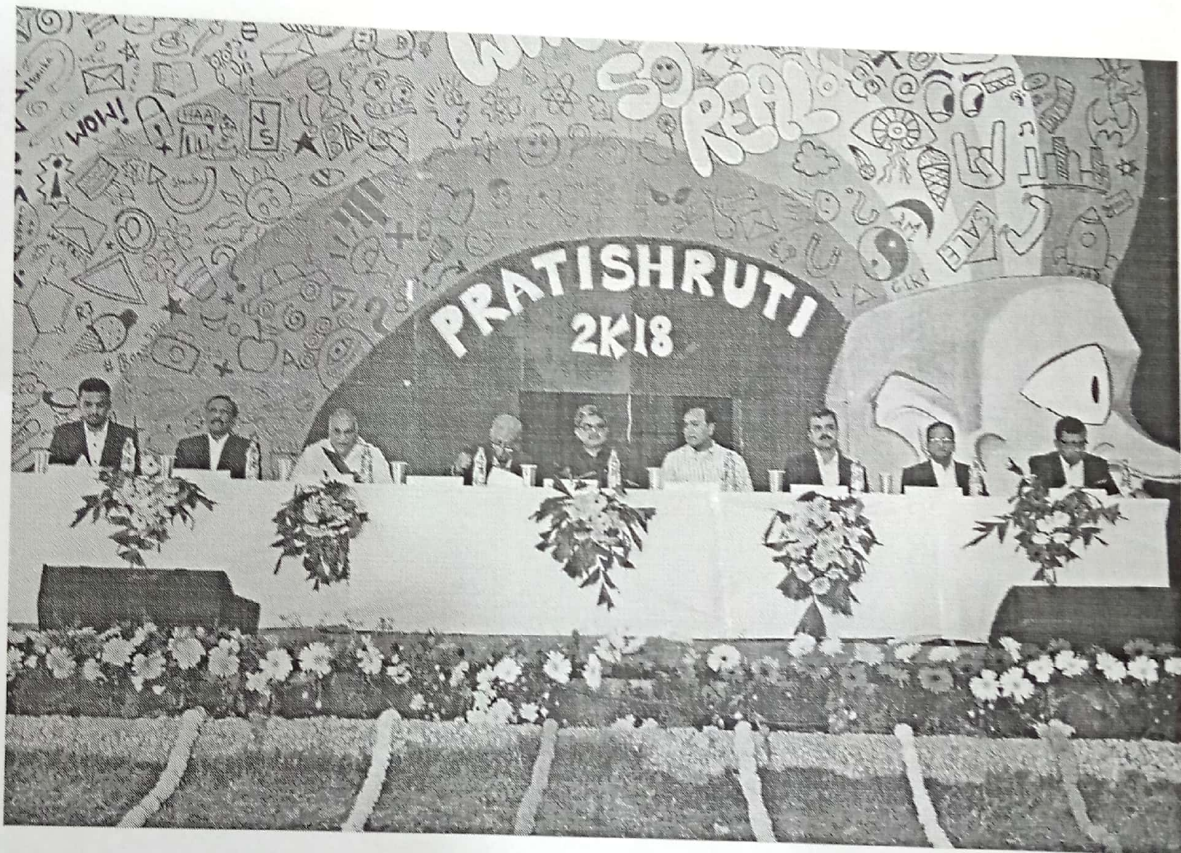
The evening was followed by dinner, the menu of which is quite liked by the students. The event was conducted and received with immense zeal, enthusiasm and happiness.

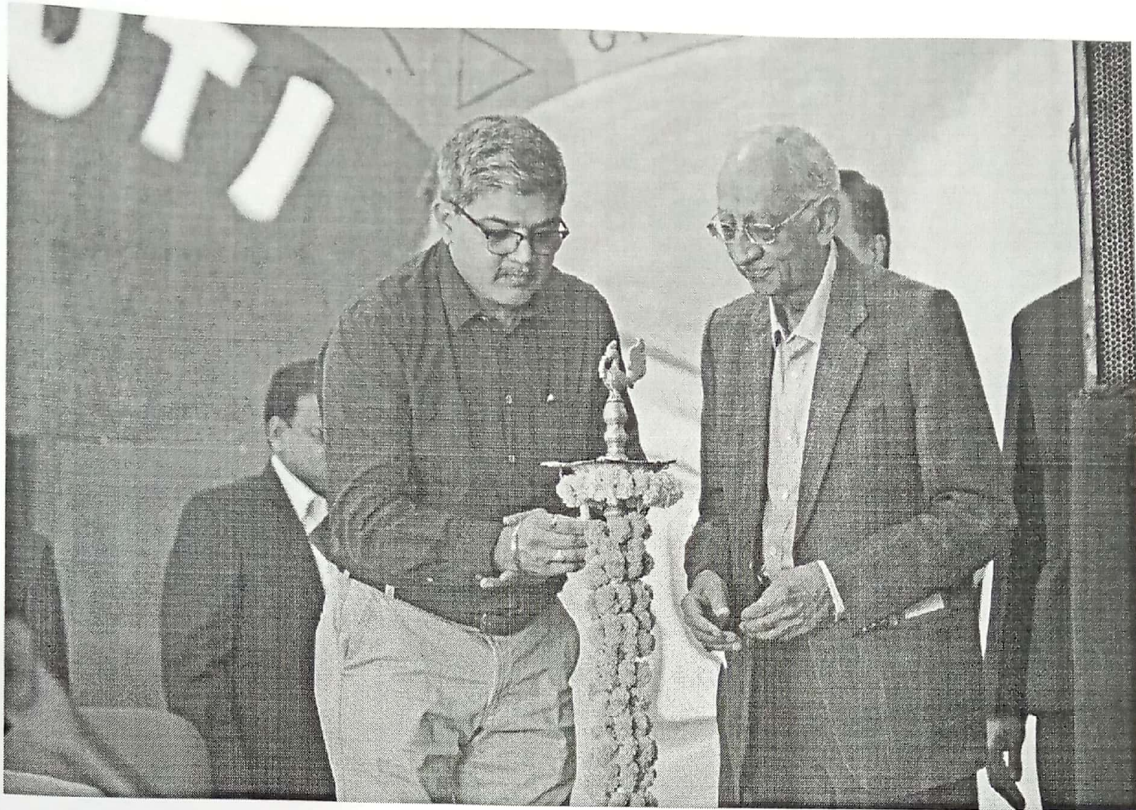

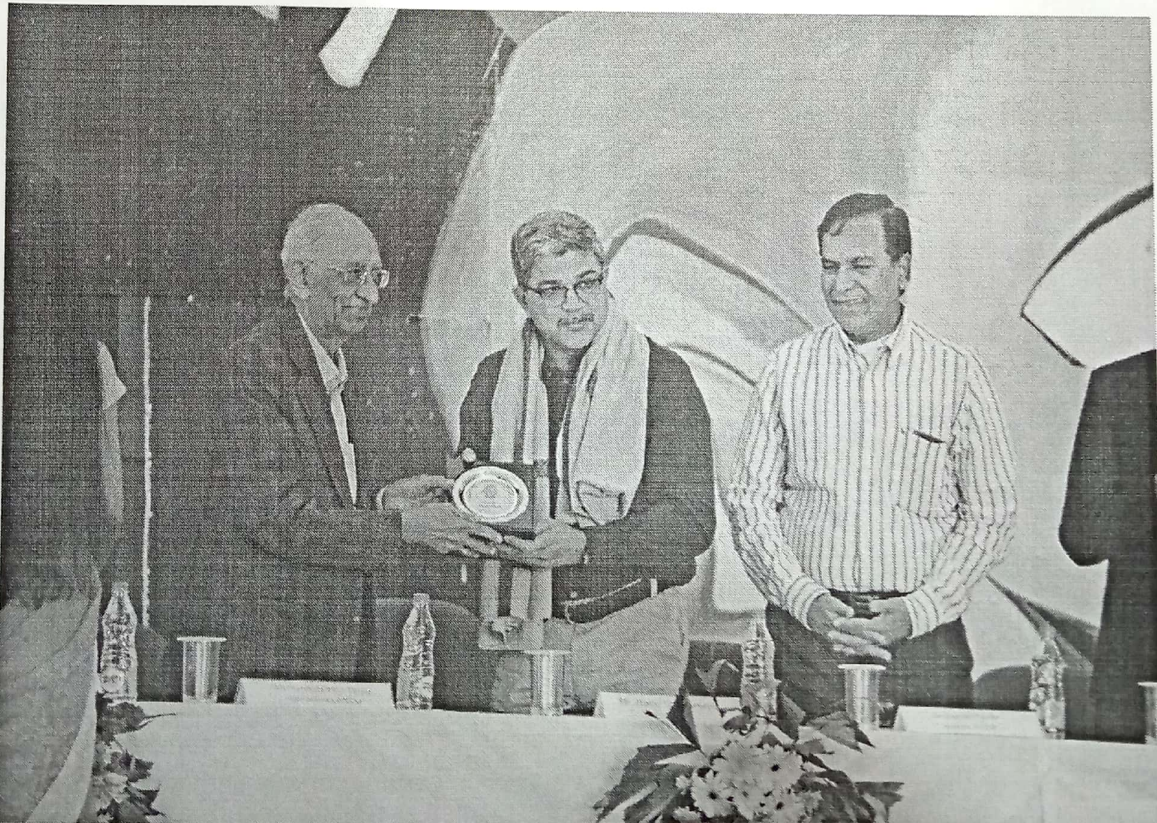
The Annual Cultural and Technical Festival 'Pratishruti 2018' was inaugurated at Shri Ramdeobaba College of Engineering and Management.

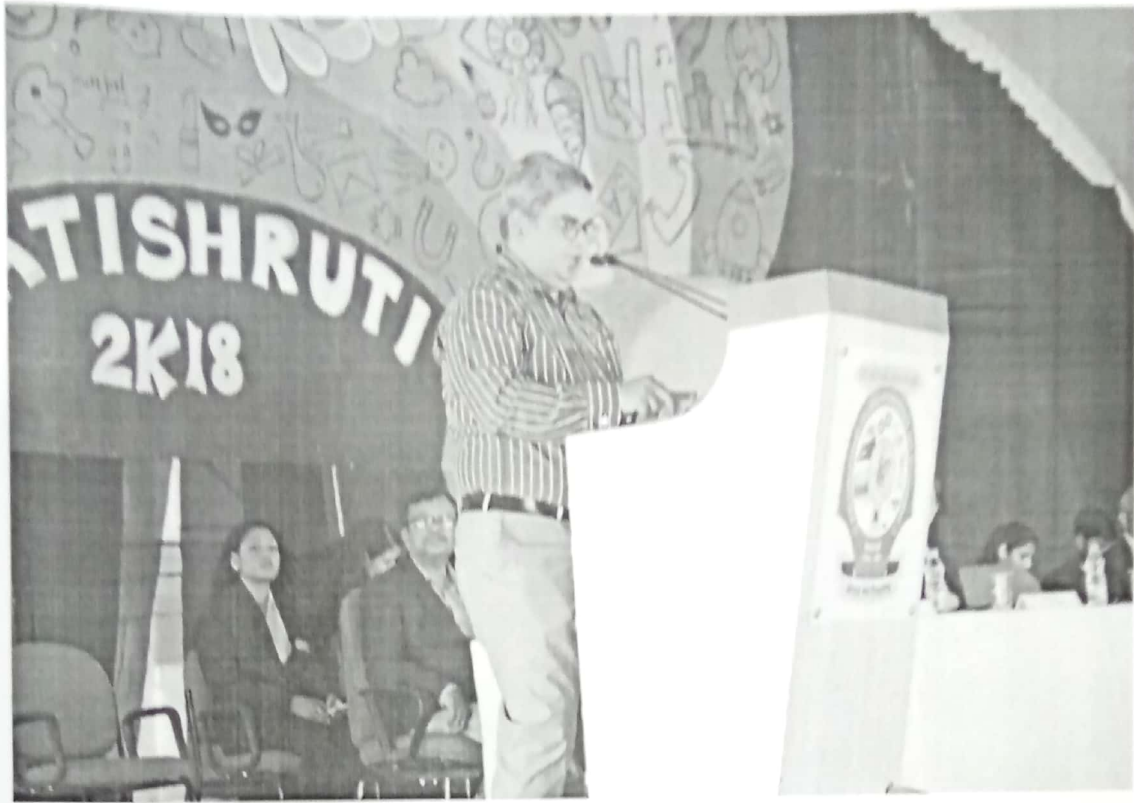
Valedictory

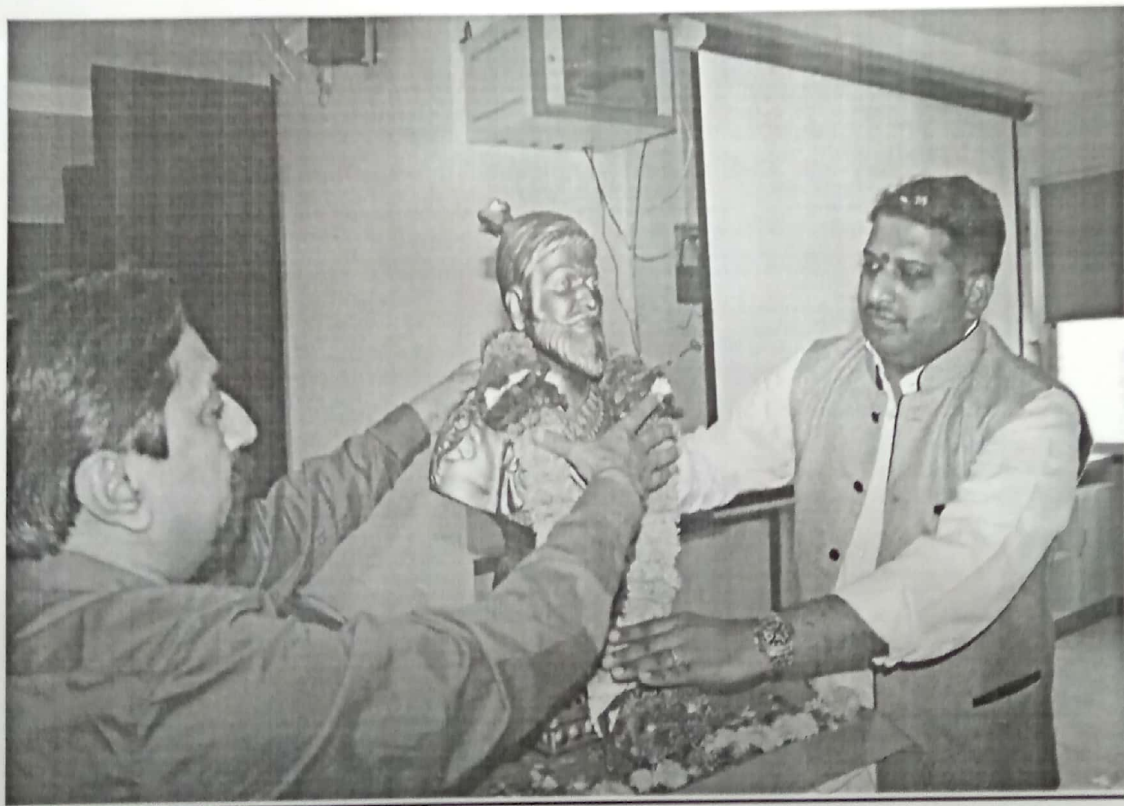

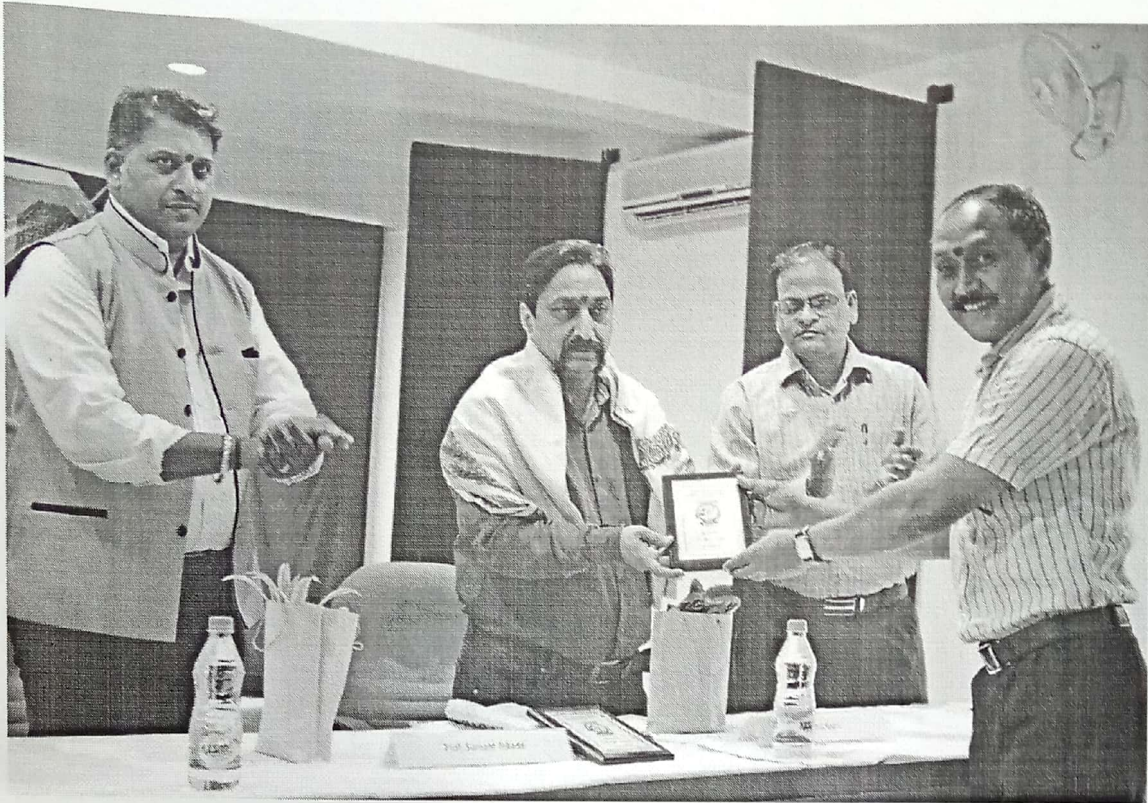


RAJMUDRA 3.0



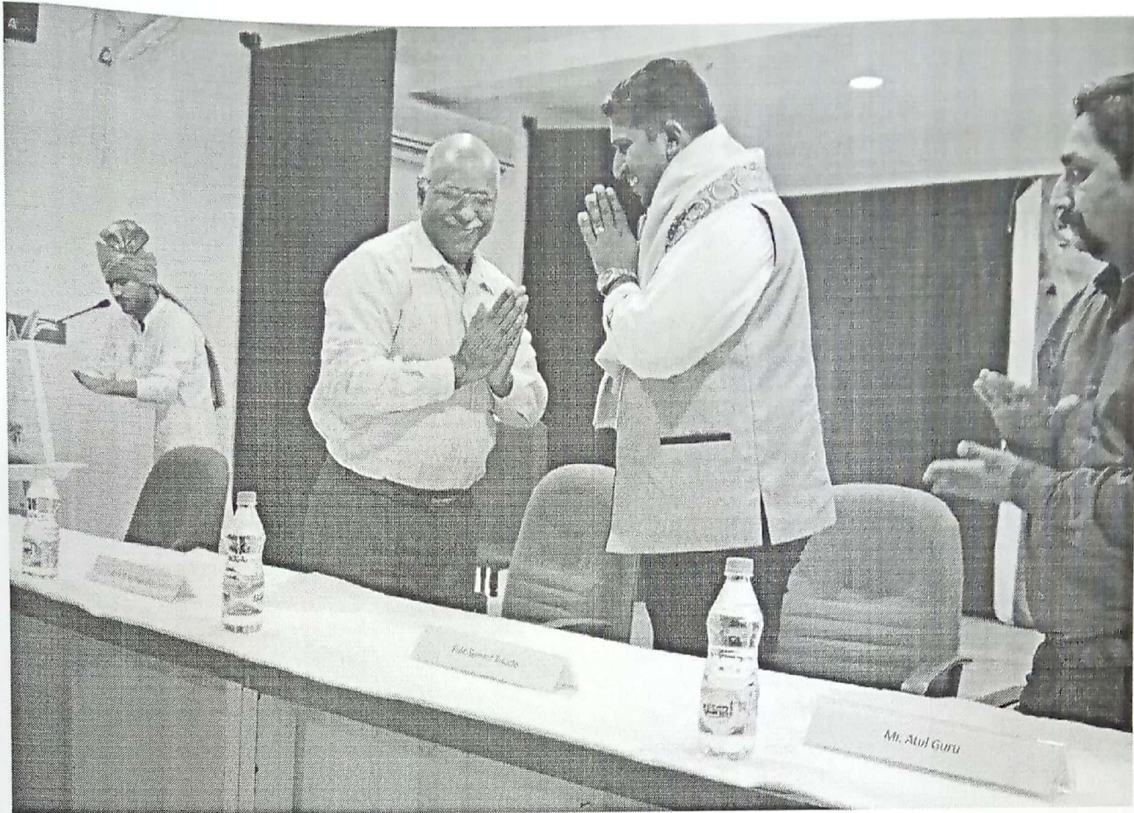


SMART INDIA HACKATHON - 2018


