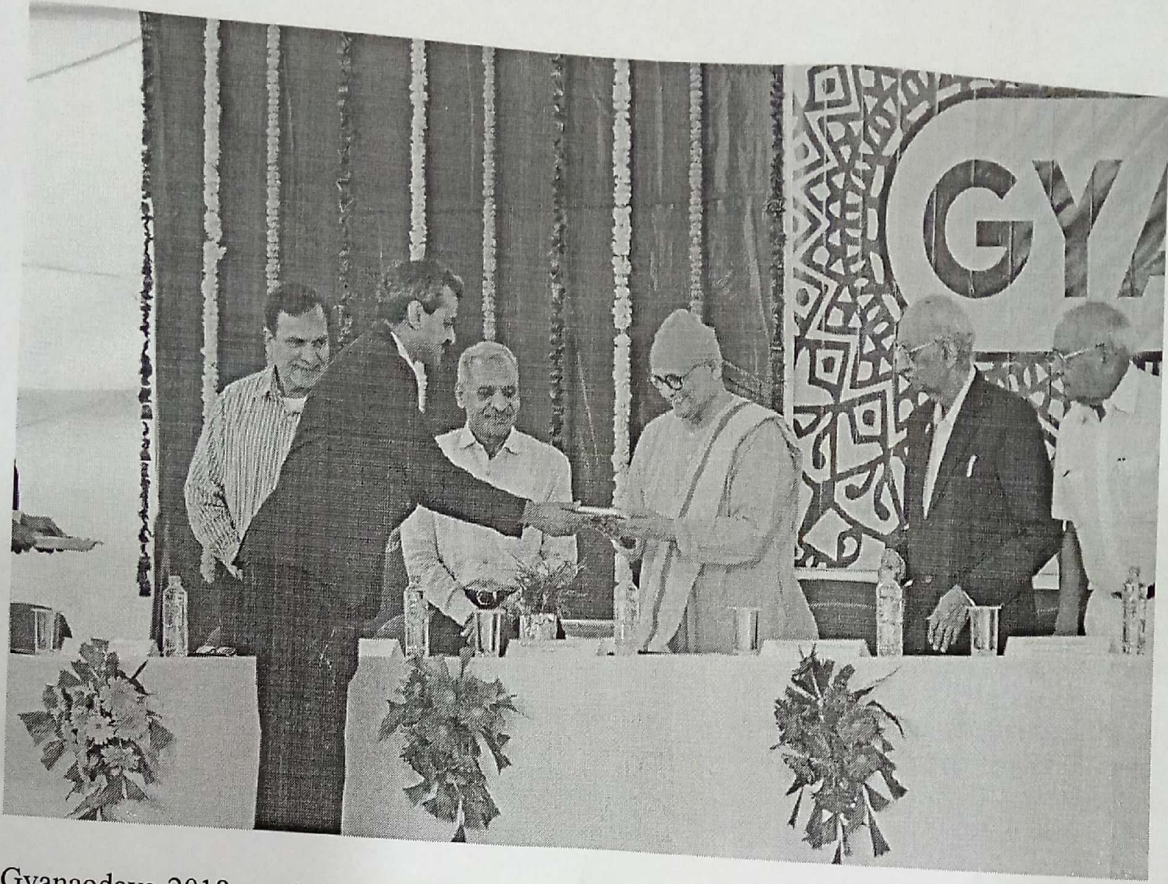



## SRC Activities Annual Report 2018-19

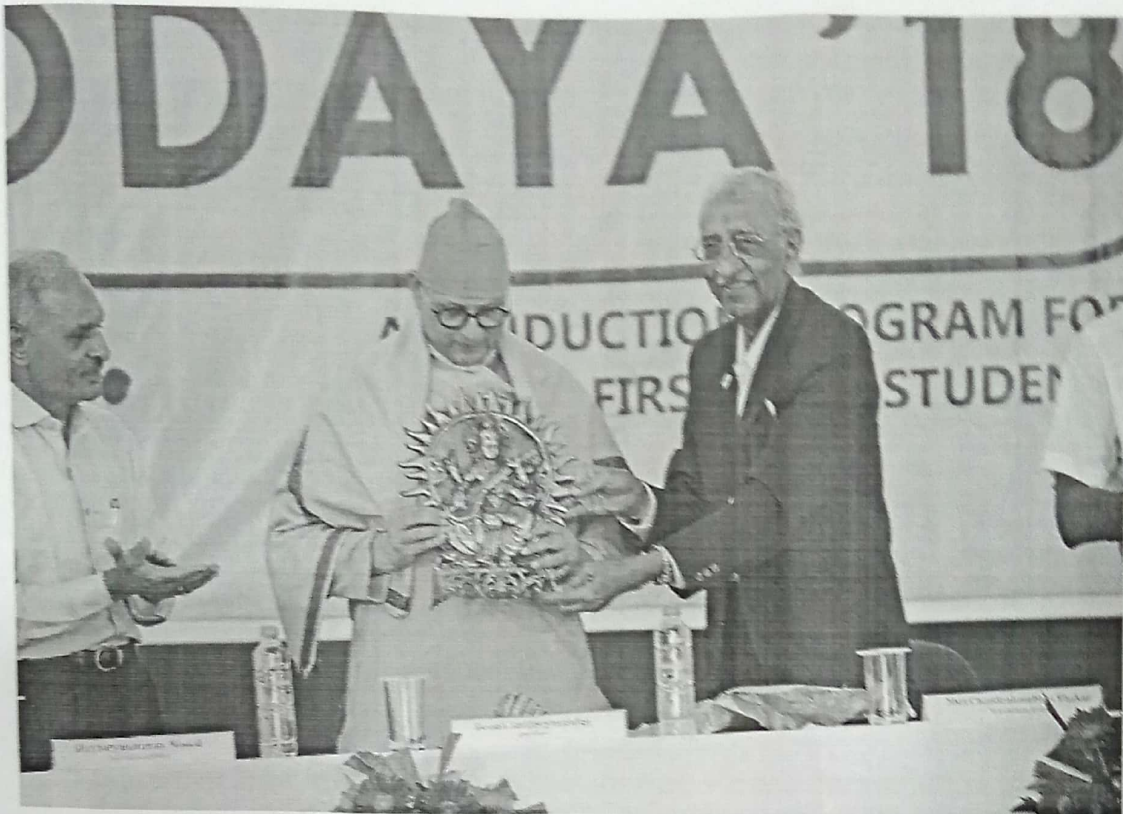
### Gyanodaya 2018

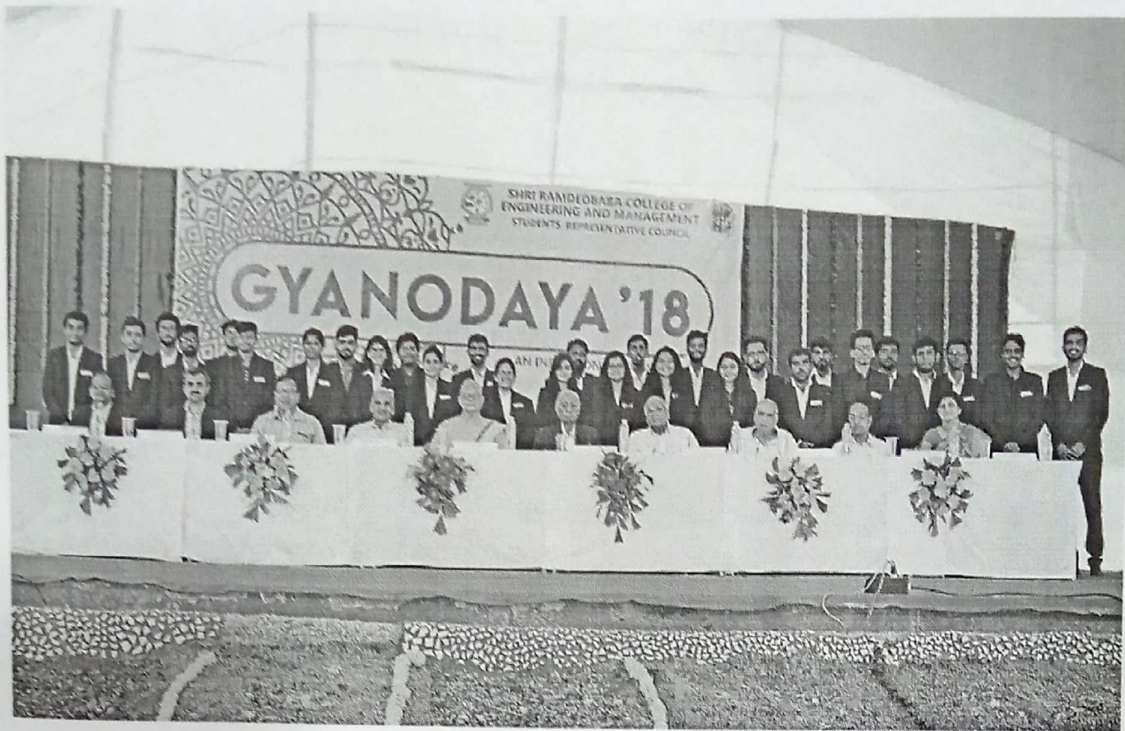

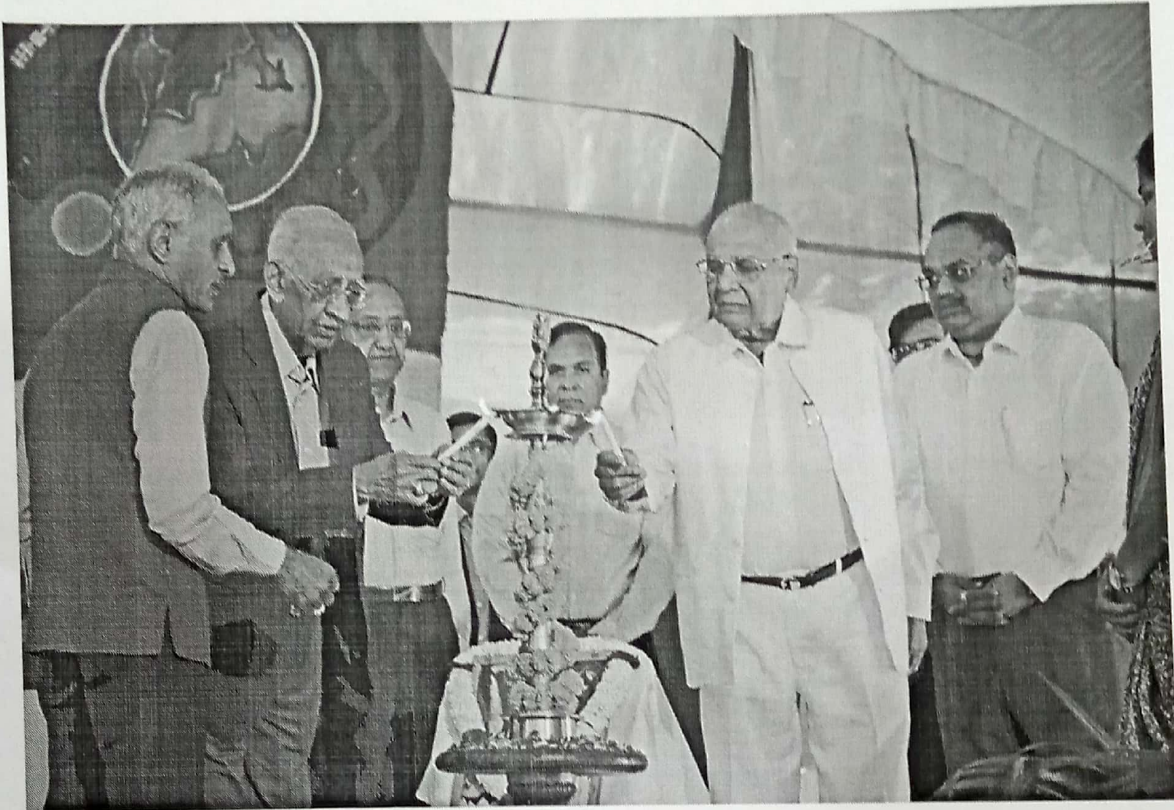


The program was well managed and coordinated by Gagan Chordiya, Cultural Secretary SRC along with the entire team SRC and team Aaruni'18.

## Pratishruti-2019

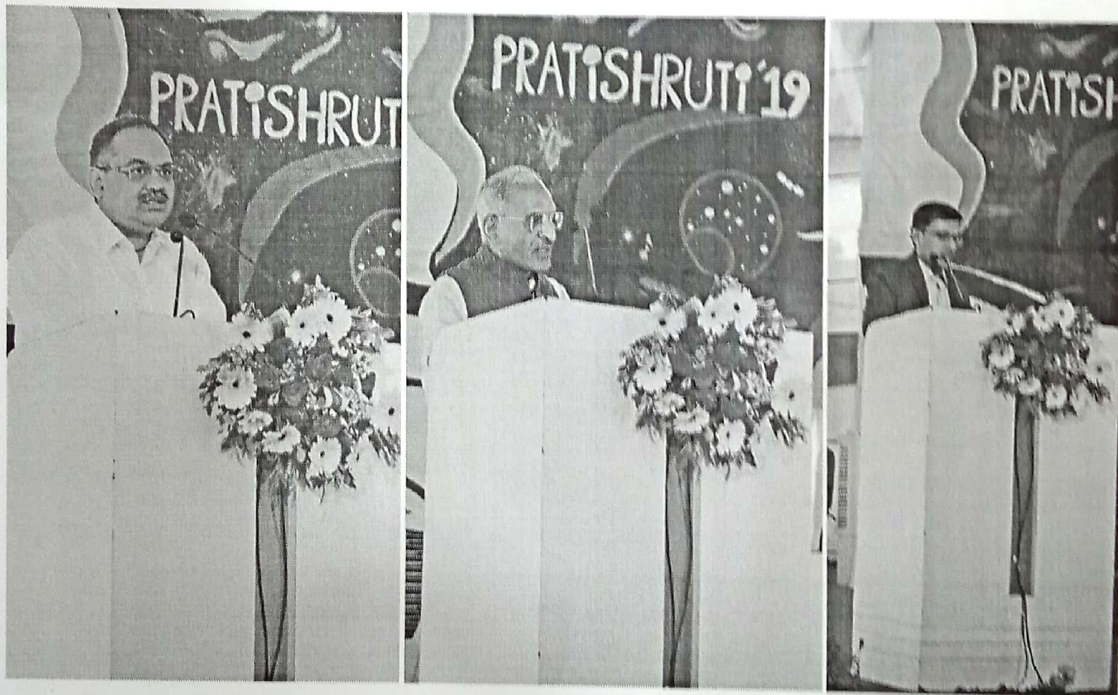

#### **One Must Go Beyond Duty- Ghanshyam Ahuja**

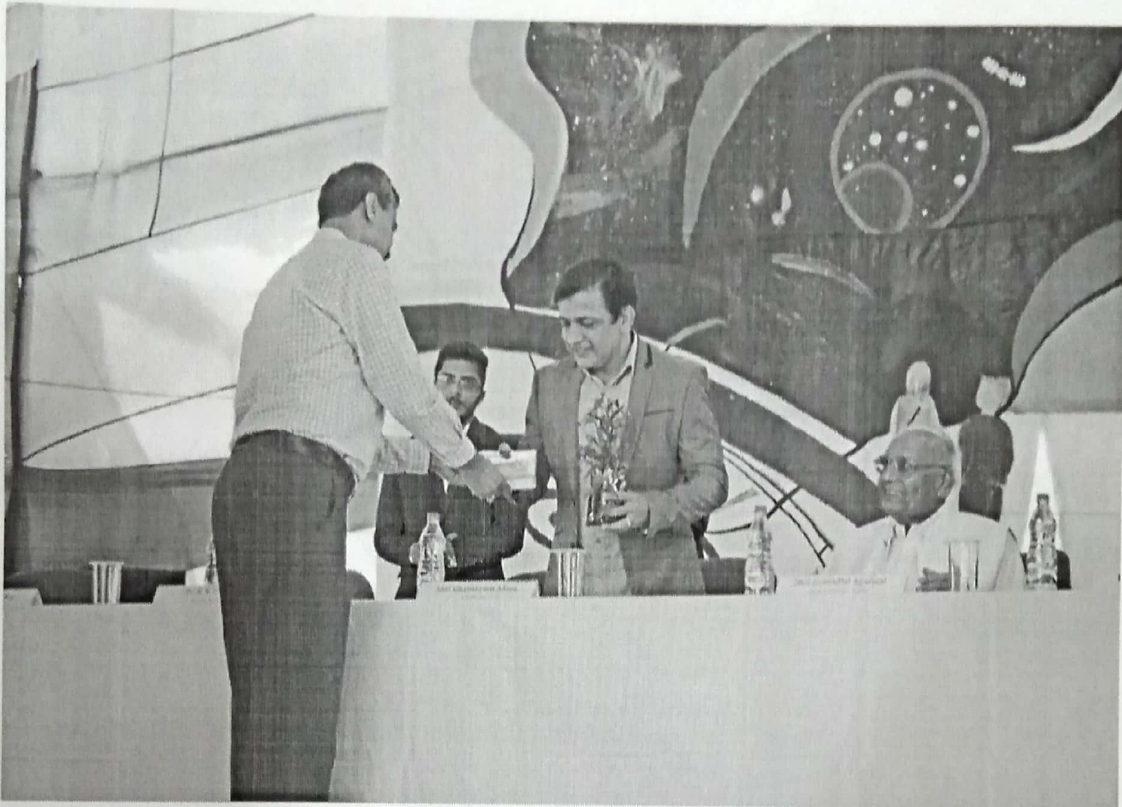

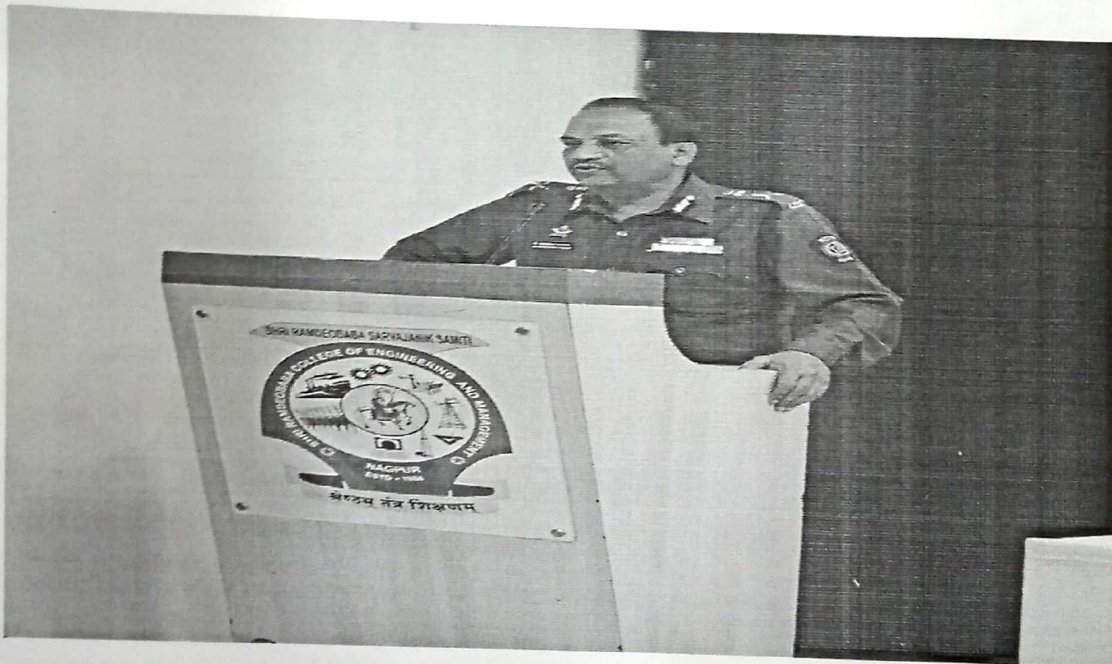
### **Cops Launch 'Chhaatra Police' Initiative and Movie at RCOEM**

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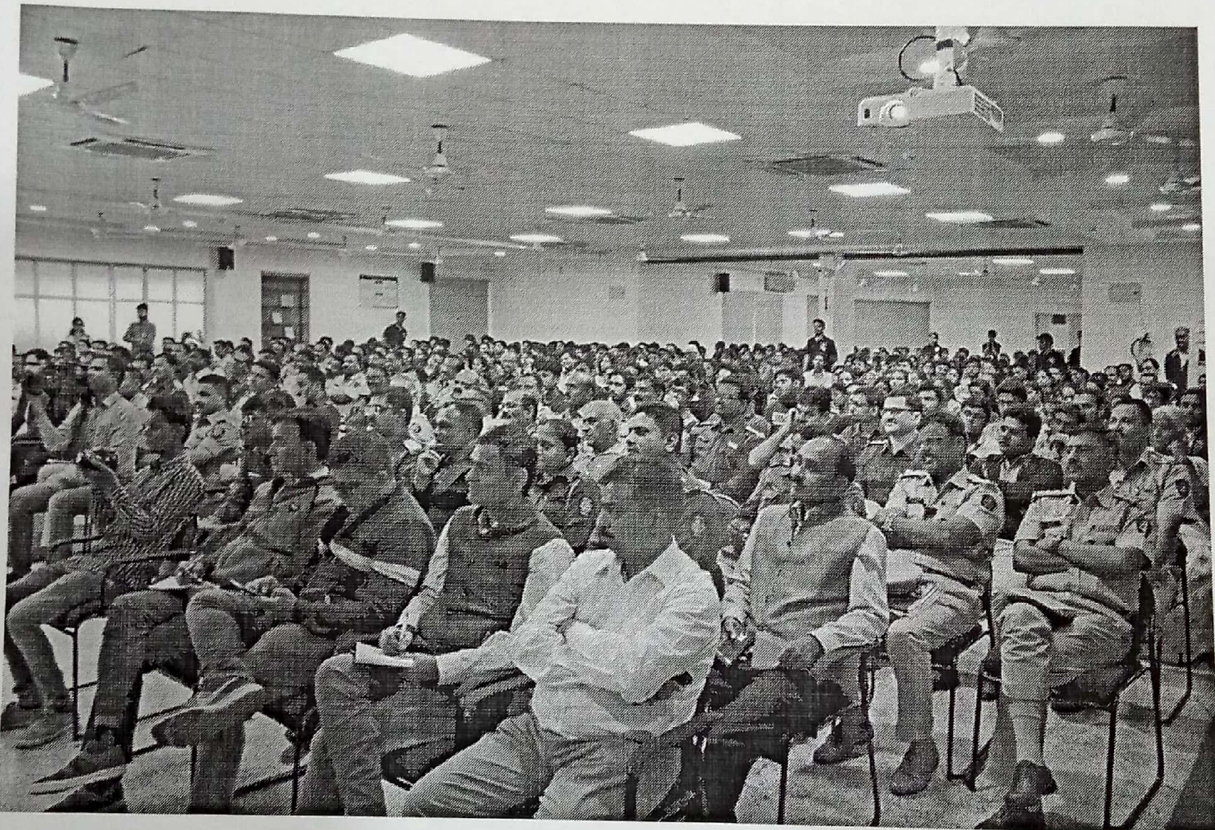

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taking the law of hands. He further said that more than one lac people lost their lives in road accidents every year in India. This road fatalities can be reduced by following traffic rules. He opined and urged the students to obey it as duty. He also alerted the students about consumption of drugs and said that youth are falling prey to drugs faster than even before which is every dangerous for the society, the CP claimed that terrorism was posing challenge to the society.

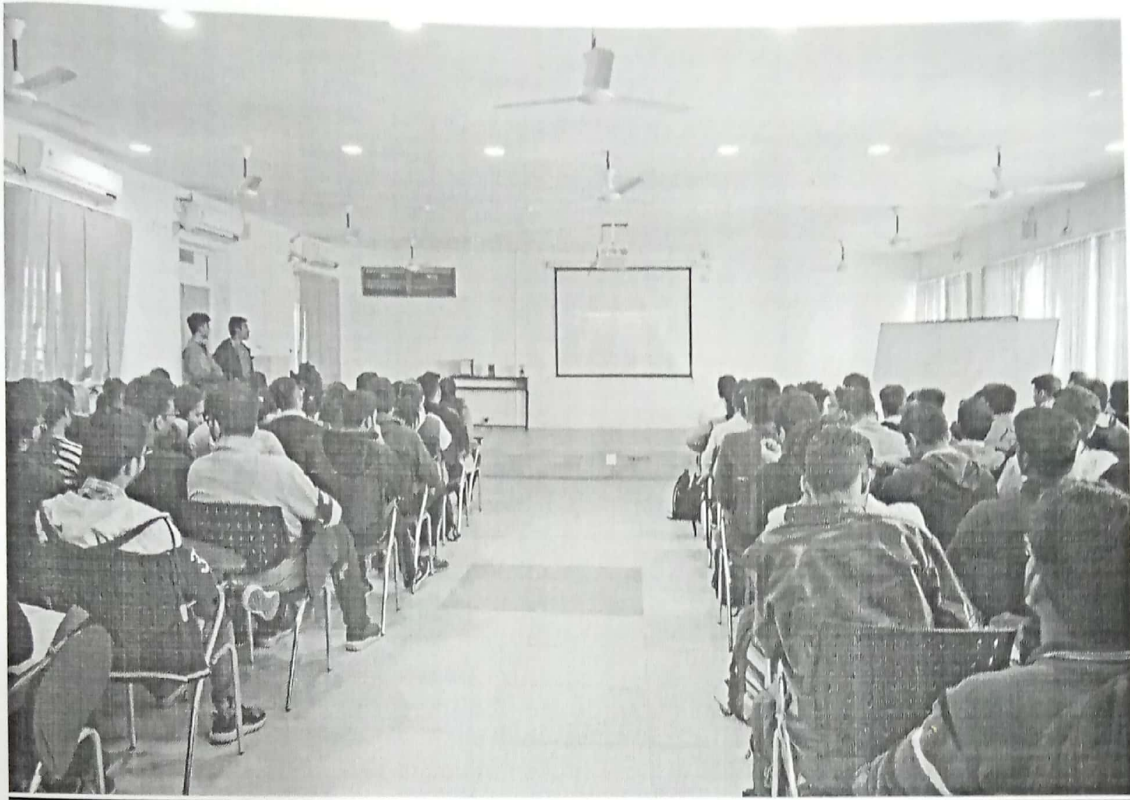

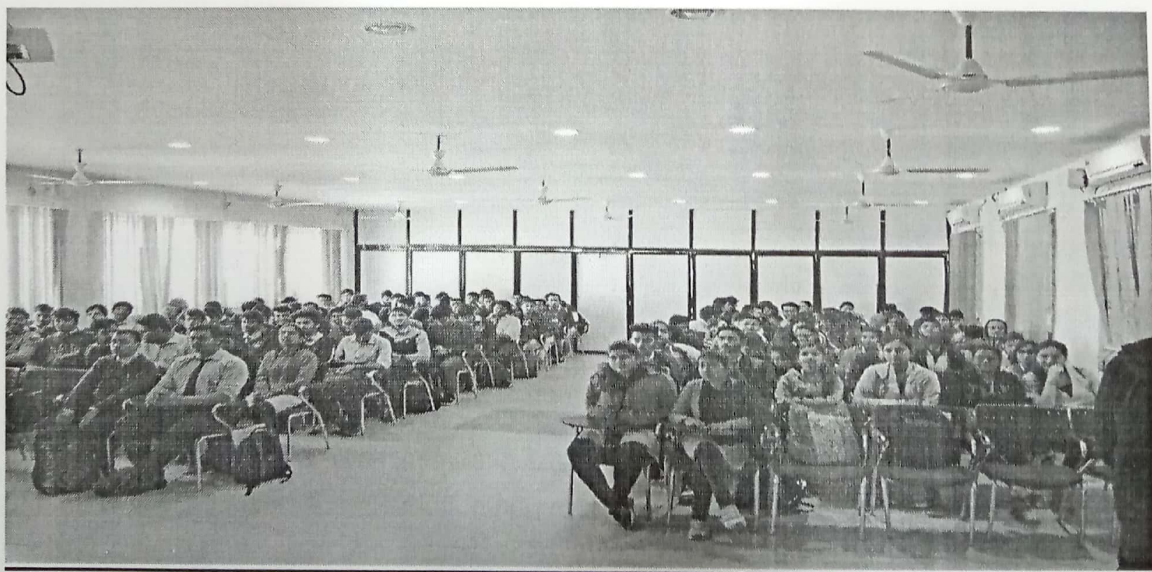


### Smart India Hackathon 2019


