
Student Satisfaction Survey (2020-2021)


The summary points extracted from the Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) are:

- 7. Students expect more sessions to inculcate life skills and employability skills.


Q.1 Degree of syllabus coverage in the class




Q.2 Teacher's preparedness for delivery of courses in the classes




Q.3 Communication skills of teachers




Q.4 Teachers approach for teaching the courses






















