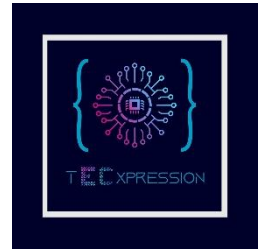




## Technical Treasure Event Report under - tECxpression 2021

The motive behind these events being to gain technical knowledge and improve interpersonal skills in fun but effective way by competing with their peers so as to get an idea of what happens during placements.

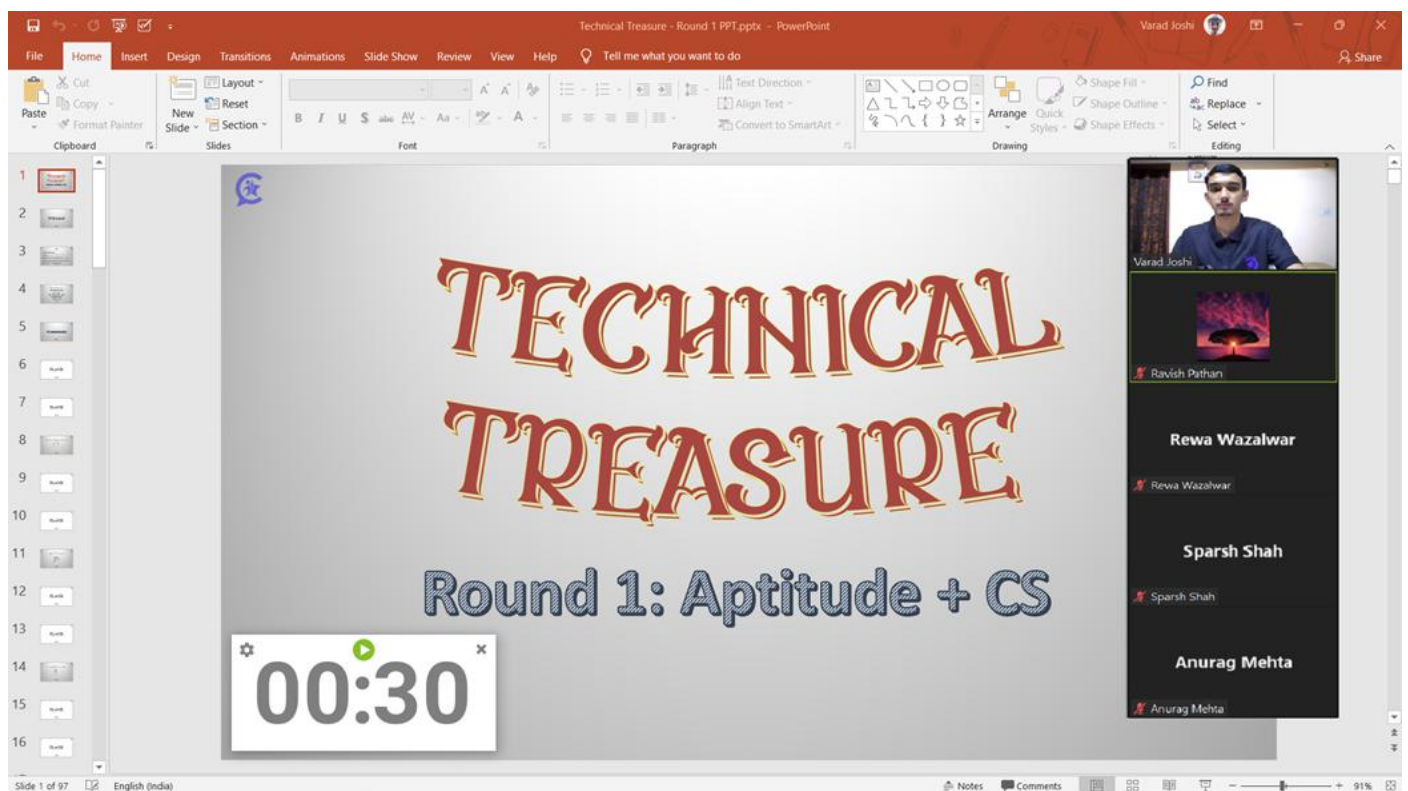
### Description of event:

#### **Technical Treasure-**

This event was conducted to gain technical knowledge and to clarify all the queries & questions that you have been shocking the seniors with PLACEMENTS. The event tried to give an exact experience of what it would be like to be sitting in a campus recruitment of an MNC. Students participated in a group of 4 people.

#### **Round 1**

All participants were asked to join a Zoom meeting where MCQ questions (based on Aptitude + Coding) were to be answered in stipulated time limit of 25-30secs. The questions were shown live in the meet and the participants marked the answers in a google form which only had options in it. The group average was calculated and accordingly participants qualified for the next round.

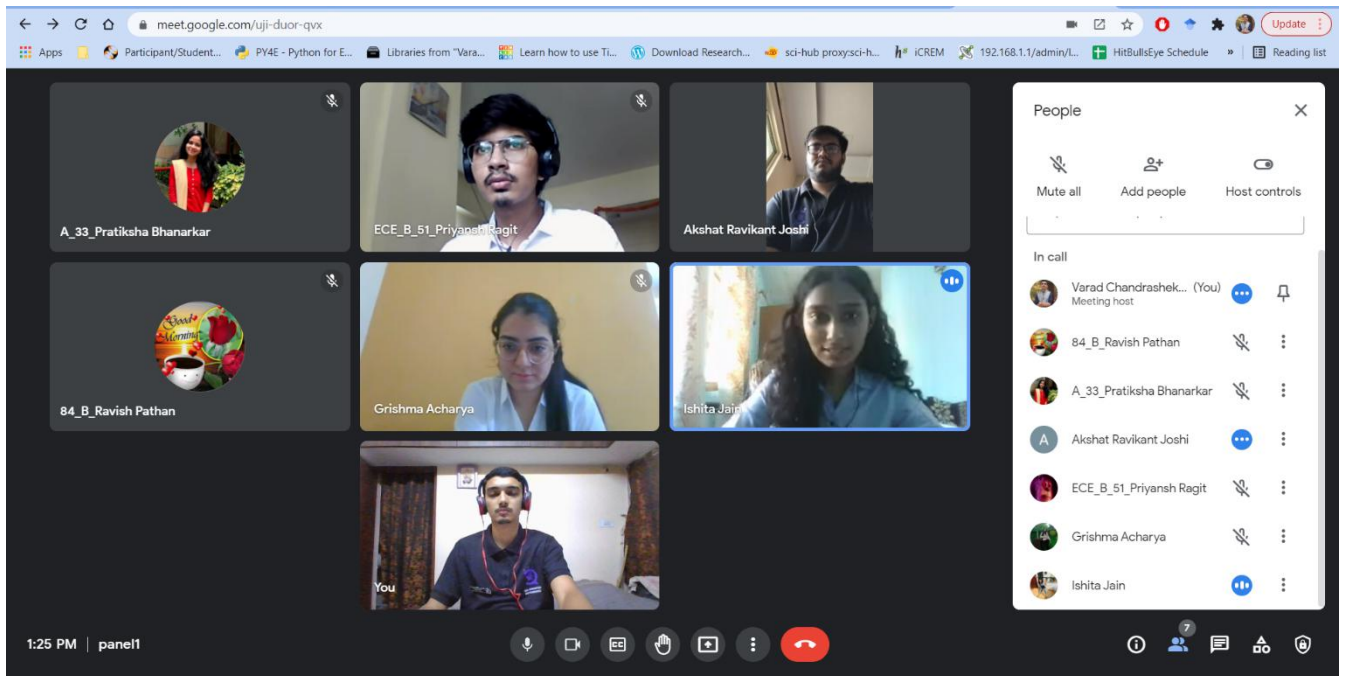
