With this thought in mind, MadhurShetye took a lead of a task of collecting items for Chennai relief. When they shared this plan with their parents and Rotary Club of Mihan Town, they appreciated the efforts and helped the cause by giving a sum of Rs 10,000.

Along with an organization named "The Climbers" took up the task. The Climbers helped the students in sending the packages to the destination. The task started by making a list of the things needed. Since dry ration, clothes and medicines were at the priority list, the students focused on these items only. The message was forwarded on social media and by word of mouth. The members and their colleagues helped them in collecting the things. The activity was carried out from 7-9th December, during which the members had their end- semester exams also, but the flame of humanity drove students towards the completion of the task. Finally on 9th December, they organized all the materials and packed them in gunny bags and boxes.

22 bags of clothes(all in good condition), 55 kg of rice, 35 kg of dal, 102 kg of sugar, medicine worth Rs 2800, toiletries worth Rs 3050 and an amount of Rs 15,300 was collected and handed over to "The Climbers", who collected packages from some more organizations and took them to Chennai.
