
Student Satisfaction Survey (2023-2024)


The summary points extracted from the Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) are:




2. Teacher's preparedness for the classes




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3. Teachers' ability to communicate
















13. Teachers identify students 'strengths and encourage them by providing right level of challenges










